We achieve this by collaborating closely with over 300 dedicated partners, from grassroots organizations to national institutions, ensuring wheelchairs, crutches, and mobility carts reach those who need them most - people living with disabilities.

Among our most valued allies is the Administration Police Service of Kenya (APS), whose officers embody the spirit of community policing. Far beyond enforcing law, they uplift lives, fostering safer, more inclusive neighborhoods. Today, at a heartfelt ceremony in Nakuru, Rift Valley Region, the APS took its commitment to new heights by donating 8 mobility carts. These carts are not just vehicles; they're gateways to independence, allowing recipients to traverse markets, attend school, visit family, or enjoy daily aspirations without the barriers of immobility.

Mama Wanjiku, a resilient mother from a nearby village, had been housebound for years with a leg injury. With her new cart, she has reclaimed her dignity as she rolls to the market to sell her vegetables and support her children. Juma, a bright student's world expanded only as far as his crutches allowed—now, he cycles to school, his laughter echoing through the streets. These carts will empower 8 families, ripple into dozens more, and strengthen the bonds of community trust that the APS nurtures daily.

**Rift Valley Police Commander John Amadadi, speaking at the handover, captured the essence of this partnership:** *"These mobility carts are more than donations; they are tools for justice and equality. As we police our communities, we also propel them forward—one life at a time. Partners for Care's vision aligns perfectly with our duty to serve and protect every Kenyan, especially the most vulnerable."*
