Overview



The goal of Partners for Care (PFC) minimart program is to assist mobility cart beneficiaries to start businesses. PFC donates coolers to mobility cart beneficiaries in partnership with Mobility Worldwide, MO–Columbia. PFC staff have distributed 1,850 coolers to people living with disabilities. PFC partners with county governments, religious institutions, charity organizations (Rotary, Lions Club), community based organizations among other groups who assist the beneficiaries with startups.

To date, 1,250 beneficiaries have established businesses.
