#### **2023 HIGHLIGHTS**

Mary Wang'ang'a, Mobility Carts and Strategic Communications Director, won a DIAR Award in the PWD Inclusion category for the impact of her work in the mobility program.

Received and distributed **11** containers. Nine containing mobility carts from Mobility Worldwide and two containing adaptive equipment from Friends of Disabled Adults and Children.

Successfully launched the PFC Branding Hub and received an in-kind donation of equipment worth over \$3,000.

Received a donation of two new computers from the PLO Lumumba Foundation for our prison computer schools program.

Hosted a 15-year celebration in Kenya with staff, board members and strategic partners.

We assembled the first mobility cart in Kenya from a completely disassembled cart sent by Mobility Worldwide Missouri - Columbia.

Produced two mobility cart prototypes from locally sourced materials and parts.

Started the journey in Trans-Nzoia County of fulfilling Mel's Vision of all Kenyans mobile.

Distributed 201 WaterSafe backpacks impacting 4,787 school children through a partnership with the PLO Lumumba Foundation in Siaya County.

Successfully launched the vaccination program for children in our medical clinic.

Achieved the milestone of reaching the 47th county through the Mobility Carts Program.

Hosted our first Virtual Elephant watch parties in Kilifi, Nairobi and Marsabit.

Created our online INUA e-commerce store in Kenya and the U.S. Opened an INUA shop at the **PFC** house.

Our work was featured **16** times in the media; this was a combination of TV, print and digital platforms.

Our founder, with David Fischer, PFC Board Member, and Tony Black, Flexible Packaging Solutions, presented the WaterSafe backpack at the Michigan State University/USAid Food Aid Sustainable Packaging Workshop in Lansing, Michigan attended by USAid, World Food Bank and other NGOs.

I want to express my most sincere appreciation for our donors. Without support of hundreds of donors **PFC** would not be able to reach the most vulnerable in Kenya and change their lives.


